Principal's Report: Mr. Donnie Hopper

- OMS is in the top 10% in the state.
- The 12 hour volunteer requirement returned this year. Will be tracked electronically by using a QR code. Hours
 can be earned for attending outside school events, PTO meetings and events (not sporting) held at school.
 Opportunities will be posted on FB, school page or sent out via Parent Square.
- FSA replaced by FAST. Testing 3 times a year Aug, Dec and May. Testing done on 1 day ELA and Math.

 EOC Civics for 7th grade in May. EOC Algebra and Science for 8th grade in May is still required. Testing allows student levels to be tracked throughout the year. Results will be posted in Focus. FAST parent portal coming soon. Last year's FSA scores in FOCUS and hard copy can be picked up in the office.

- Sports Most sports have 70 -90 students tryout. 12 members are selected for the team. Programs are not rec programs and not all students will get a chance to play. Top players will get the most play time and coaches will work with all students to improve skills throughout the program. Cross Country allows for more participants. 75 runners are allowed on the team and must meet the 2 miles in 20 mins requirement. Most runners will participate in meets.
- Clubs Garden club has been successful and meets every other week. TSA club met on 9/8 with 40 students.
 Chess club, rubik's cube club and Students Against Destructive Actions starting soon.
