IMPORTANT REMINDERS:

- Open House is a chance for you and your child to move throughout the building, at your own pace. You'll be able to visit with every department we have here at OMS—Language Arts, Reading, Science, Social Studies, Math, and Electives.
- We use a 8-period schedule this year. All students go to four periods on one day (1, 3, 5, 7), and four periods (2, 4, 6, 8) the next day. Each class is 77 minutes. Students have 5 minutes to transition to each class. We will not use a 10-period schedule like all Lee County middle schools.
- Our school hours for students are 7:40 a.m. 2:20 p.m. Students may arrive on campus at 7:10 a.m. or later. They must be in class by 7:40 a.m. to avoid being tardy. Breakfast is served each morning until 7:30 a.m. the cost is \$2.00. Lunch is \$3.25.
- Our main form of communication to parents this year is done through Google Classroom a web-based/app learning management system. Teachers also check their email daily.
- Uniforms are required. A copy of our uniform policy can be found on our website. Jeans may be worn by students on Friday's only if they purchase a Jeans Club Pass for \$25. All shirts do need to be embroidered with our logo.
- Gifted and Talented Education (GATE) all students eligible for gifted services will be in the GATE program. Additional students may be in the GATE program based on available seats and their most recent FSA ELA scale score.
- Students scoring at Level 4, 5 on FSA ELA, Math will be placed in Advanced Classes. Intensive academic support is provided to students in Tier 2, 3 of MTSS.
- This year, homework may only be given my math teachers. Long-term projects may be assigned by any teacher.
- The elective classes we offer this year are PE, Art, Band, Drama, Dance, Technology, STEM, Spanish, Careers, Leadership, Study Skills, TV Production, News Crew, Health, and Spanish.
- We offer a variety of intramural sports, and we compete against all of the Lee County middle schools. Sports include basketball, cross country, volleyball, soccer, golf, tennis, and track & field.
- We also offer a great variety of after school clubs. Clubs offered this year include National Junior Honor Society, Student
 Government, Builders Club, Garden Club, Explorers, Drama, Photography, Technology Student Association, Fitness Training,
 and Cheerleading.
- We are a Positive Behavior Support (PBS) school. Students are rewarded for making good choices. Special events take place throughout the year for students consistently following our expectations—Be Respectful, Be Responsible.
- Our student drop-off and pick-up area is located behind our campus. To access, pull into the main driveway at Oasis High, remaining to the far right. Follow the lanes to the back of our school.
