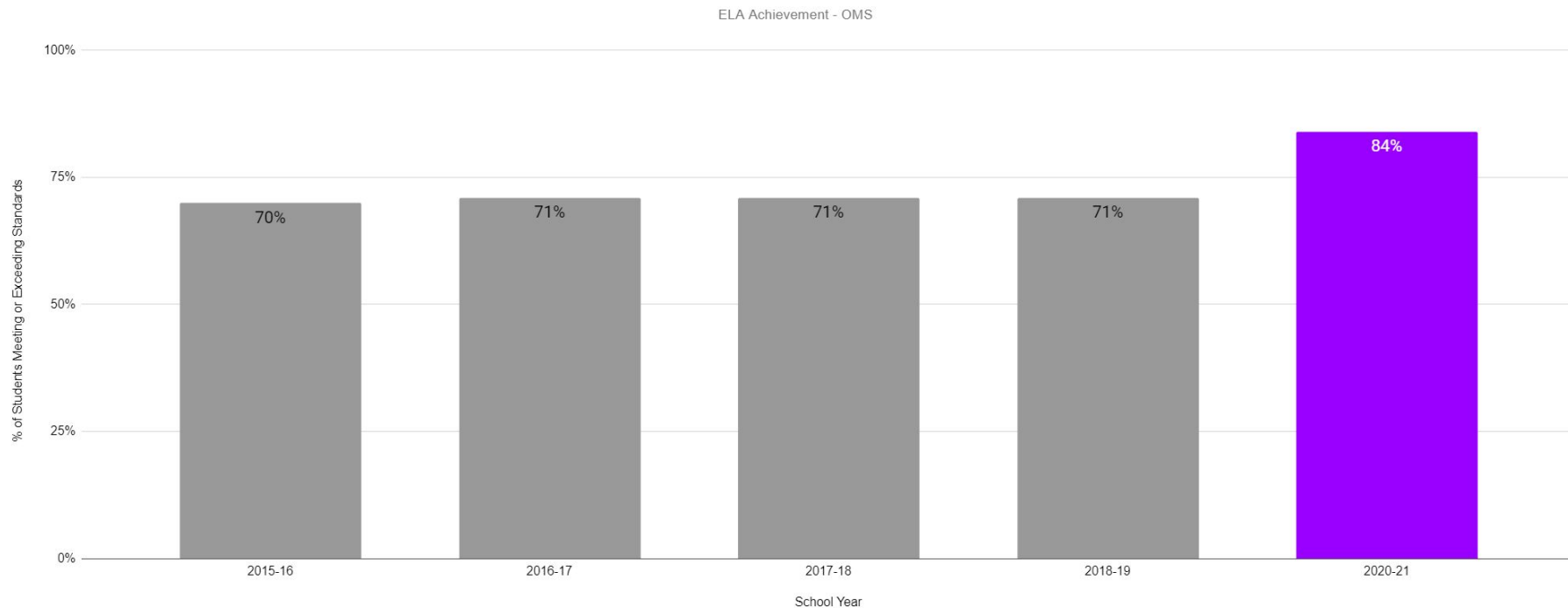

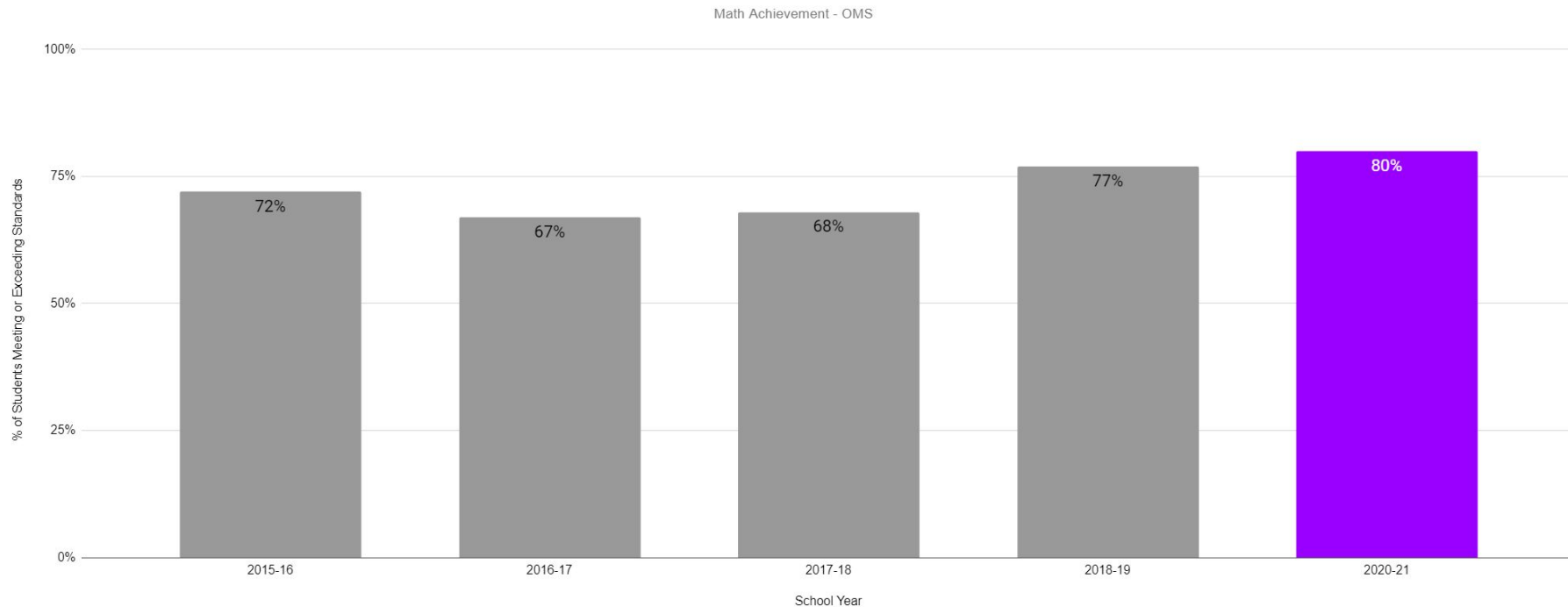

 - Electro-static spraying

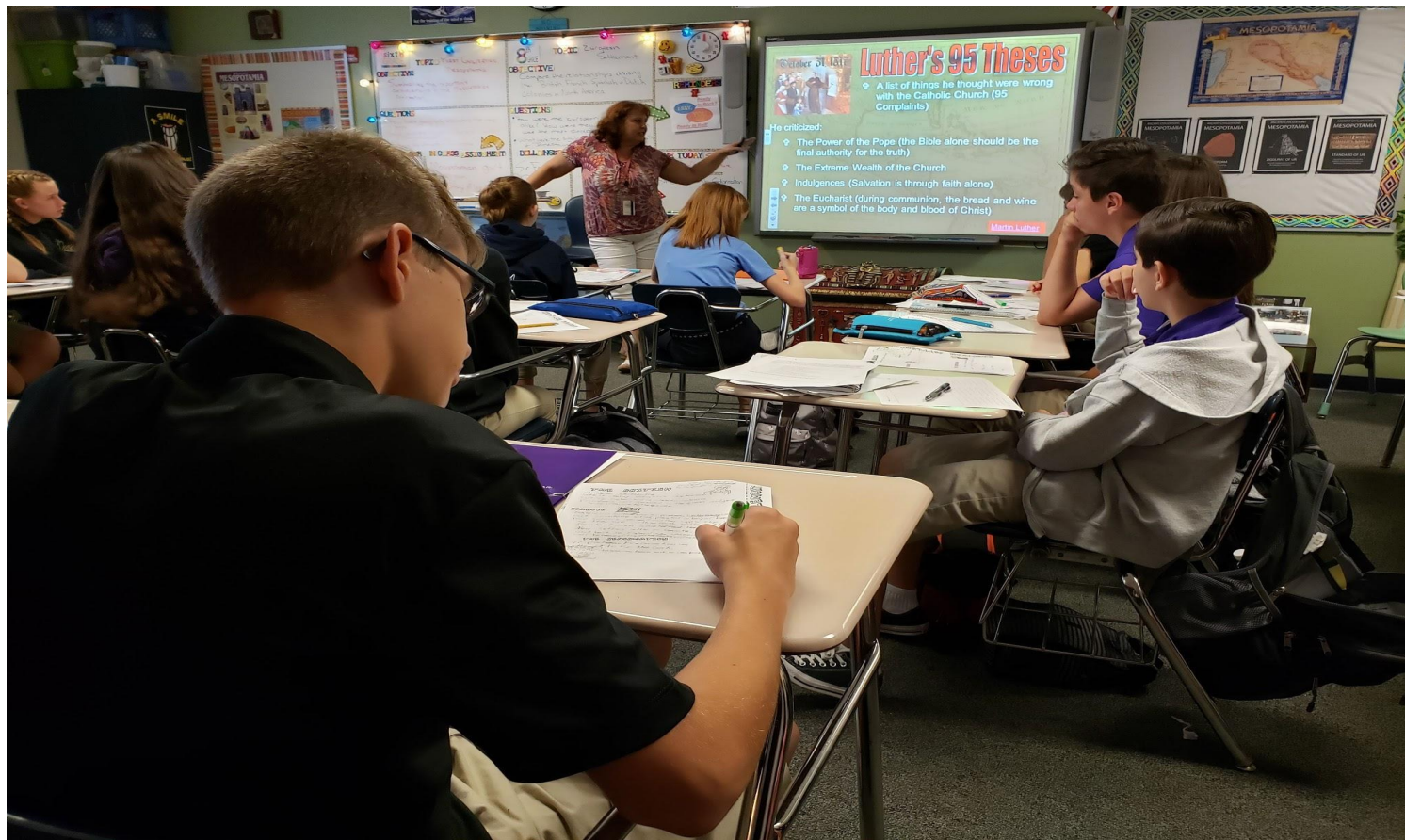

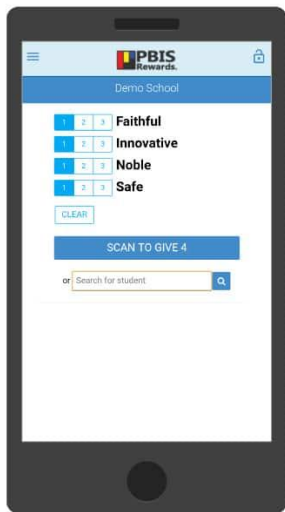
Be Respectful

- Please no gum.

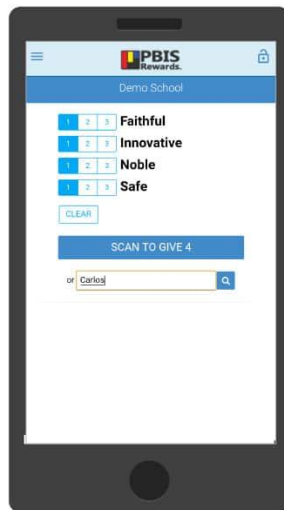
Be Responsible

- Use class time wisely.

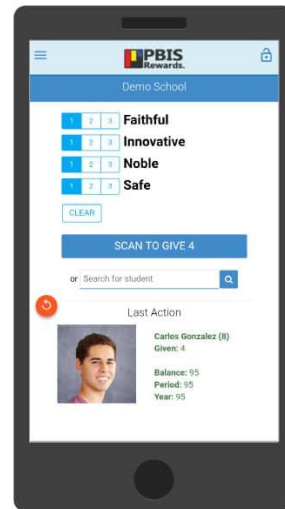
