- Student hours are 7:40 a.m. 2:20 p.m.
- ♦ Students have 10 periods in their schedule. Each period is 63 minutes.
- Uniforms are required. The full dress code policy can be found on our website www.oasismiddleschool.net
- A full time Cape Coral Police Officer is stationed on our campus, serving as our School Resource Officer (SRO).
- Our top priority is ensuring students are educated in a safe, secure environment. Our administrative team (principal, assistant principal, school counselor, school social worker) works with our school resource officer to provide this for all students.
- All families are required to volunteer a minimum of 12 hours each school year.
- A fee-based after school program is available to students from 2:20-4:20 p.m. The cost of this program is \$25 per week.
- ◊ Free after-school tutoring is available for students who are not passing.
