## AVID Curriculum

Based on rigorous standards, the AVID curriculum was developed by middle and high school teachers in collaboration with college professors. ## The Tutorial Process

All AVID students at OMS have a tutorial session weekly to provide support in their academic classes. AVID-trained college tutors facilitate the discussion and work at each group to foster an envrionment in which students feel secure asking the questions that they might be uncomfortable asking in their core-content classrooms.

Fridays in AVID classes are often used to focus on student success through the use of motivational activities that also incorporate the academic skills of writing, inquiry, collaboration, organization, and reading.
