**Principal’s Report:** Mr. Donnie Hopper

Mrs. Collins update

- Oasis conducted a Classification and Compensation Study by Evergreen
  - All Job classification were analyzed in the study including substitute teachers.
  - Oasis teachers and staff received an average increase of 12.5% in FY 25
- Oasis Sports Complex 100% of the design concept to include
  - Field and track
  - Stand for 1700
  - Concession Stand
  - Locker/weight room
  - Restroom/Storage
  - Athletic trainer office
  - Additional parking for 300+
- Aftercare
  - OES and OEN will take over aftercare next year (morning and evening)
    - Opportunity to bring in revenue for the school
  - OMS already run an After Care Program
- Watching SB 296 Bill deletes the requirement to start no earlier than 8am for middle schools and 8:30 high school.

- 88% matriculation rate from OMS to OHS, if this rate continues to increase, by FY 29 we will need to expand OHS to accommodate all internal students as per our charter.

Mr. Hopper update:

- Shrinking Schedule for 2025:
  - 6 period schedule next year, Block schedule will disappear for next year
    - Reduces the number of electives
      - 4 core classes all year/2 electives per semester
    - Reduces the number of teachers needed.
  - 8<sup>th</sup> grade graduation –
    - 3 tickets/students due to capacity issues
    - Possible streaming of graduation
