What is JROTC?

We are a cadet led program meaning the students in the program get to help with making decisions about battalion events.

JROTC is meant to help students graduate high school with qualities and information that will help cadets to navigate life after high school.

JROTC gives you leadership positions that will look good on resumes and show you can take charge if needed and can communicate effectively.



Events

Our battalion offers two field trip opportunities throughout the school year. We have our winter trip to Busch Gardens and our end of year trip to Universal Islands of Adventure. We also have other events including: battalion barbecue, veterans day parade, military ball and more.



Scholarships

Almost all JROTC events offer cadets volunteer hours which are necessary for those looking to acquire the Bright Futures Scholarship. There are also senior ROTC scholarships available.

OMS PTO Update FY25

Teacher Compensation

- Oasis conducted a Classification and Compensation Study (July – December 2024) by *Evergreen Solutions, LLC*.
- All job classifications were analyzed in the study including substitute teachers.
- Oasis teachers and staff received an average increase of 12.2% in FY 25.
- The next study will be conducted in FY 28.
- Influx of Local Capital Improvement funding has allowed us to provide raises.

Oasis Sports Complex

- Currently working on completing 100% of the design concept to include:

- Multi use field and track
- Stands for 1700 people
- Concession Stand
- Locker/weight rooms
- Restrooms/storage
- Athletic trainer office
- Additional parking (300+)



Miscellaneous but Important

- OES and OEN will run Before and After Care programs next school year. OMS will run an After Care program. No longer will programs be run by Parks and Rec Department.
- Watching SB 296 Middle School and High School Start Times: this bill deletes the requirement to start no earlier than 8:00 am for middle schools and 8:30 am for high schools.
- Currently there is an 88% matriculation rate from OMS to OHS. If this rate continues to increase, by FY 29 we will need to expand OHS to accommodate all internal students as per our charter (projected matriculation of 91% to be 1013 students).
