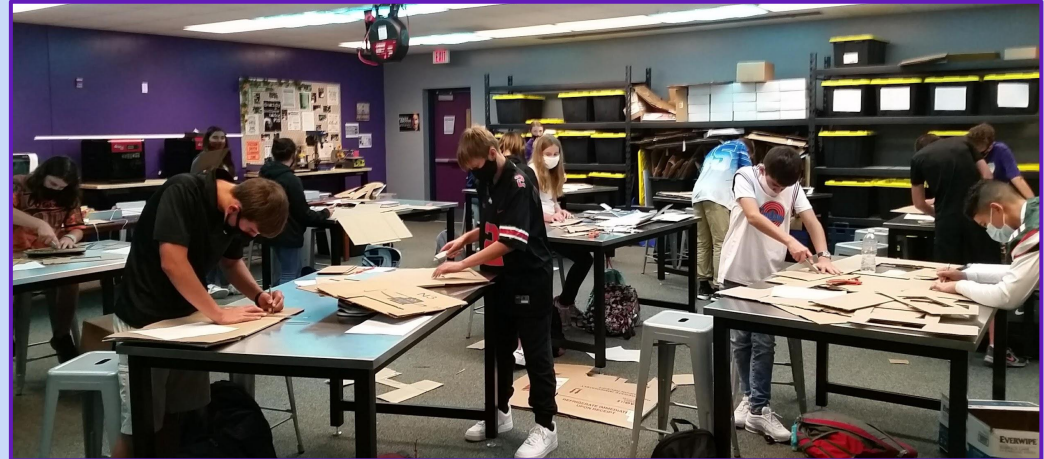
WHAT IS THE PURPOSE OF THE GATOR GARAGE MAKERSPACE?

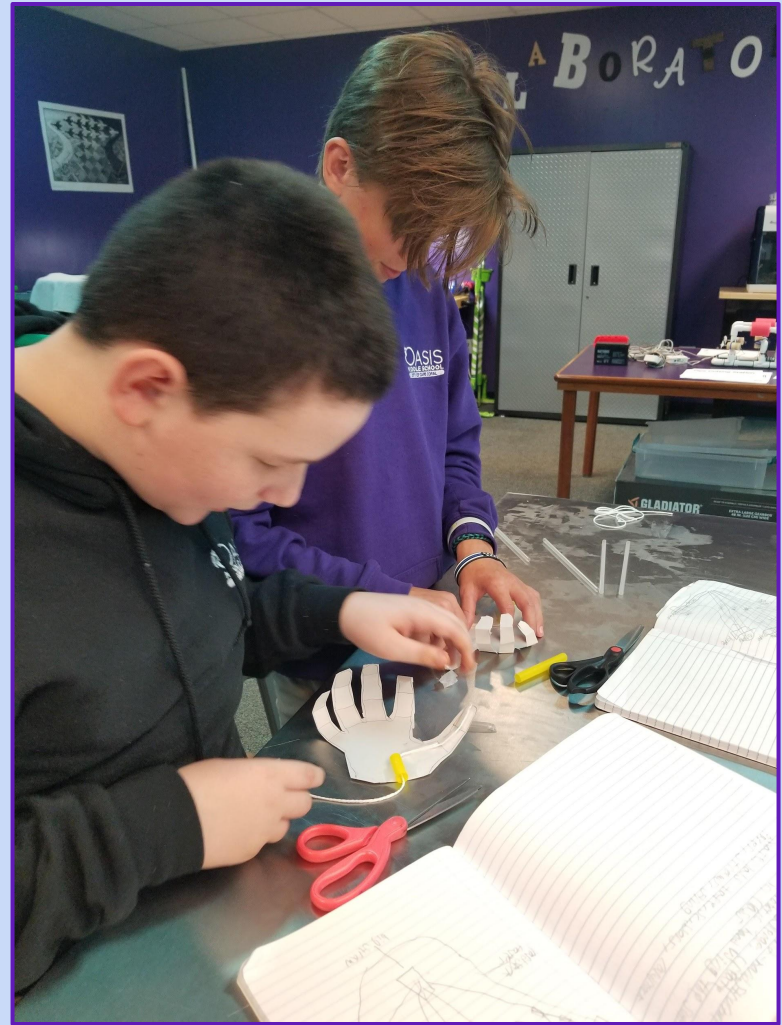

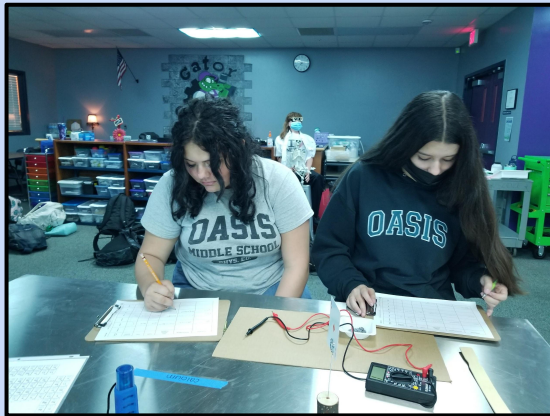
